

**TENDER NOTICE FOR SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, TESTING & MAINTENANCE OF
CCTV SURVEILLANCE & MONITORING SYSTEM FOR ENFORCEMENT
DIRECTORATE KRO, ZONE-I & ZONE-II**

1. Directorate of Enforcement, Kolkata Regional Office, 6th Floor, CGO Complex, DF Block, Sector 1, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064 invites sealed tenders under Two-bid system from experienced and eligible Contractors for supply, installation and maintenance of CCTV Surveillance & Monitoring System for ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE, Zone-I & ZONE-II, Kolkata.
2. The interested agencies are required to submit the technical and financial bids separately. **The bids in sealed Cover-I containing “Technical Bid” and sealed Cover-II containing “Financial Bid”** should be placed in a third sealed cover bearing the words “Tender for Implementation of CCTV Surveillance & Monitoring System” and should reach the Office of the Special Director, Directorate of Enforcement, Kolkata Regional Office, 6th Floor, CGO Complex, DF Block, Sector 1, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064 by 11:00 A.M. on or before 22th March 2022 (including holidays). Formats of Technical Bid and Financial Bid are given at **Annexure-I and Annexure-II (A & B)** of this document respectively. **Tender Bid will be opened on 22-03-2022 at 12 PM.**
3. The Scope of Work and the Terms and Conditions are provided at **Annexure-III** of this document.
4. A complete set of tender documents along with terms and conditions can be obtained free of cost from Office of Special Director, Directorate of Enforcement, Eastern Region, 6th Floor, CGO Complex, DF Block, Sector 1, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064 on all working days. Soft copies of the formats at Annexures I & II in Microsoft Word format are also available at the office and can also be requested by sending email to admn.kol-enforce@gov.in. Further these can also be accessed on the departmental website **<http://www.enforcementdirectorate.gov.in>**. Any inquiries in the matter may be made during office working hrs. at Ph. No 033-2321-9210 [AD (Admn)/ EO (Admn)].
5. Tenders can also be sent by registered post/speed post on and before the last date of submission ensuring that the same is not tampered with and the envelope is properly intact. The last date for submission of tender is 22th March, 2022 at 11:00 A.M.
6. Tenders received after the stipulated time and date will not be considered under any circumstances. This office also reserves the right to reject or cancel any bid without assigning any reasons.
7. Earnest Money (EMD) or bid security of Rs.100000/- (Rupees one lakh only) shall be submitted by the bidders in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft in favor of the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, Enforcement Directorate, Kolkata shall be accepted. The



original instrument in respect of Earnest Money should have validity period of 45 days beyond the final bid validity period & must be submitted with technical bid, failing which bid shall be summarily rejected without consideration. Exemption /Relaxation of depositing EMD shall be applicable as per existing Govt. Rules.

8. The EMD of the bidders who are not selected will be refundable within thirty days after the completion of the tender process. No interest would be payable on account of EMD. The EMD will be forfeited in case the bidder ask for modification in his /her bids or do not accept the contract after being awarded the same. The EMD of the successful bidder would be returned only after entering into the contract for the hiring period and submission of a Bank Guarantee for equivalent amount.
9. The Successful bidder will have to furnish a Performance Security of amount equivalent to 3% of the expected annual value in the form of either a Bank Guarantee, valid for 60 days beyond the term of the contract, issued by a scheduled bank as per format at **Annexure – VI** or a Demand Draft issued by a Scheduled Bank, favouring “DDO, Enforcement Directorate, Kolkata”. No claim shall be made against Government of India / Deputy Director (Admn.), Enforcement Directorate, Kolkata in respect of interest accrued, if any, due on the Performance Security Deposit.
10. The performance of the engaged agency will be assessed as on regular basis and the agency ready to meet terms and conditions as stipulated in NIT should submit their bids. **Technical bid shall include documentary proof in respect of each of the aforementioned points of Technical terms and conditions. Financial bids of Agencies, failing to fulfill the above conditions, will not be considered.**
11. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by bidders having business relationship among themselves. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another [i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common] be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
12. The bid forms and other details can be obtained from the CPPP Portal website **<http://www.eprocure.gov.in>** .
13. Bidder who has downloaded the tender from the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website **<http://www.eprocure.gov.in>** and department website **<http://www.enforcementdirectorate.gov.in>** shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be summarily rejected and EMD would be forfeited and bidder is liable to be banned.

ANNEXURE-I

Scope of Work

Installation and maintenance of CCTV surveillance and monitoring system for ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE Kolkata Regional Office, Zone-I & ZONE-II, Kolkata.



- a) Bidder has to comply with latest BIS standards for the supply of CCTV & NVR (with latest features including Access control systems-alarm transmission, Video-loss/Tampering detection Video Content Analytics systems, global standards-ONVIF support)- combined and/or integrated systems even fire detection and fire alarm systems (limited to command, control software and associated systems)- Intruder and hold-up alarm systems (including perimeter intruder detection systems) etc. complying above BIS or identical IES Standards. Other allied equipment for the installation of CCTV Surveillance Systems should adhere to BIS Standards. Bidders should comply with **BIS Standard i.e. IS 16910 (Part 2/Sec 32): 2020 or International Standards IEC 62676-2-32: 2019** in respect of video surveillance system for use in security applications, video transmission protocols and recording control and replay based on web services for guidance and use.
- b) Bidders has to comply with BIS standard IS 16910 (part2/sec 32): 2020 or identical to international standard i.e., IEC 62676-2-32:2019 standards defined for video interfaces used in video surveillance systems in security applications that also specifies the web service interface for the configuration of the recording of video, audio and metadata. Additionally, associated events are defined.
- c) OEMs/Product owners to ensure that their product complies with a set of regulations outlined in the BIS standard IS 16910 (part2/sec 32): 2020 or identical to International standard i.e. 62676-2-32:2019. Further, as the scope defines the standard is for web service interface for configuration of the recording of video, audio and metadata and other equipment must be compatible and comply with BIS standards so that in future no technical glitch would arise in synchronization and smooth functioning of the system due to incompatible equipment/technology. At any stagesuch incompatibility/synchronization issues arise vendor will be sole responsible and vendor has to replace/remove and install suitable equipment without charging further more. Following equipment/works are to be provided as per parameter mentioned in **Annexure-II**
- d) CCTV Surveillance system is to be setup in two premises. One for ER and Kolkata zone-1 (Premise 1); and other For Kolkata zone-2 (Premise 2).
- e) CCTVs are to be installed at all entry-exit points, main gate and outside the washrooms/toilets, all corridors, lobby, verandas/out houses and reception area, interrogation rooms and lockups. There are **existing 8 Cameras in Premise 1**. Number of additional **Dome Cameras** as calculated for Premise 1 is **18** and for Premise 2 is **15**.
- f) The Cameras range should be **10-30 meters minimum**, should **have night vision**withboth **video & audio** enabled.
- g) Number of **Dome Cameras** Required for Premise 1 is **18** and for Premise 2 is **15**.

- h) **Two separate 32 Channel Network Video Recorder (NVR)** are needed for Premise 1 and 2. The **08 existing Cameras in Premise1** need to be integrated with NVR of Premise. The NVR should support 8TB/or more capacity hard disk so that it may support video recording storage upto 18 months.
- i) For display, total of three monitors (two monitors in Premise 1 and one monitor in Premise 2) are needed.
- j) There should be **minimum power backup of 2 hours**, provided separately with UPS and Battery System for NVR in both premises.
- k) The CCTV footage should be stored for **at least 18 months** without any replacement of hard disk. Storage System/Backup Media should **have forensic attributes** as mentioned in BIS standard IS 16910 (part2/sec 32): 2020 or identical to international standard i.e. 62676-2-32:2019 standards defined for video interfaces used in video surveillance systems in security applications that also specifies the web service interface for the configuration of the recording of video, audio and metadata. Additionally, associated events are defined.
- l) The tender is for Supply, Installation and Maintenance of Cameras. The proposal is to be inclusive of AMC for five years (post warranty).
- m) AMC is inclusive of one dedicated technician deployed right from the installation stage in the premises for the purpose of system maintenance, trouble shooting and monitoring. Backup of the footage to be provided (as and when required) by the service provider personnel.
- n) Bidders are welcome to visit the premises and assess the technical requirements of installation of surveillance system.
- o) On successful completion of the Bid the said contract or shall install the CCTVs on all work locations within a week.
- p) During installation, Bidder shall not change the brand or specification of the product without prior approval of the DD (Admn.) Enforcement Directorate.

Other Terms and Conditions

1. ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE, KRO, ZONE-I & ZONE-II reserves the right to postpone and/or extend the date of receipt/opening of Rates/Quotation or to withdraw the same, without assigning any reason thereof.
2. The bidders are required to submit the complete rates/quotations only after satisfying each and every condition laid down.
3. The rates quoted must be written both in figures and in words and should indicate leviable taxes, if any. Corrections, if any, are to be made only by crossing out, initialing, dating and clearly rewriting. In case of discrepancy between the words and figures the rates indicated in figures shall prevail. All over writing/cutting, insertions shall be authenticated and attested.
4. Rates/Quotations should be submitted and signed by authorized person of the bidding firm with the current business address, telephone numbers and email ID (if available).



5. No deviation in the Terms & Conditions and Scope of Work shall be entertained unless specifically mentioned by the bidder in the rates/quotations and accepted by the Directorate of Enforcement. Additional Technical specifications/Standards emerging due to policy matter, may be introduced/relaxed before finalization of Tender process.
6. The Directorate of Enforcement shall not entertain any claim arising out of mishap, if any, which may take place. In the event of any liability/claim falling on the Directorate of Enforcement, the same shall be reimbursed/ indemnified by the Bidder.
7. Bidder shall in no case lease/transfer/subject/appoint care taker for services agreed to be provided to the Directorate of Enforcement.
8. No other person except Bidder's authorized representative shall be allowed to enter the premises of the Directorate of Enforcement.
9. Payment will only be made to the vendor through Bank. The successful vendor will have to provide their Bank Account Number, Branch, IFSC Code, PAN Number and a copy of cancelled cheque to the Directorate for the purpose of making payment.
10. Bidder should issue Invoices on completion of installation of CCTVs & Monitoring System at ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE, KRO, ZONE-I & ZONE-II.
11. **In case of shifting of the office of Directorate of Enforcement, Kolkata, vendor shall shift the installed integrated/part of the system at new place. Cost levied on it shall be paid as per GFR rules.**

Registered Office of the Service Provider must be located in India, (Preferably in Kolkata/ Greater Kolkata). A self-attested copy of valid Trade License should be submitted as documentary evidence.
