MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE HELD ON 19.07.2022 CHAMBER OF ADDITIONAL DIRECTOR AT 3.30 P.M. **ENFORCEMENT** DECIDE PENDING APPOINTMENTS ON THE DIRECTORATE COMPASSIONATE **GROUNDS** IN THE **OF** ENFORCEMENT.

The following members of the Compassionate Appointment Committee constituted by the Competent Authority met on 06.07.2022, 12.07.2022 and 19.07.2022 at 3.30 P.M. in the Chamber of Additional Director of Enforcement to scrutinize the applications and recommended suitable candidates for compassionate appointment:

- (i) Ms. Monika Sharma, Additional Directorate of Enforcement (Chairperson)
- (ii) Sh. Rohit Dwivedi, Joint Director of Enforcement (Member)
- (iii) Sh. Ranjan Prakash, Joint Director of Enforcement (Member)
- (iv) Sh. D.S.B. Kumar, DLA (HO) (Member as welfare Officer)
- 2. As per DoP&Ts OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013, the objective of the scheme for compassionate appointment is to grant appointment on compassionate grounds to a dependent family member of a Government Servant dying in harness thereby leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood, in order to relieve the family of the Government servant concerned from financial destitution and to help it from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.
- 3. The foremost important ground for consideration of the application of the dependent of the deceased Government servant for compassionate appointment is that the family is indigent and deserve immediate assistance for relief from financial destitution.
- 4. Applicant for compassionate appointment should be eligible and suitable for the post in all respects under the provisions of the relevant Recruitment Rules. However, upper age limit could be relaxed by the appointing authority wherever found to be necessary. Appointment made on grounds of compassion should be done in such a way that persons appointed to the post do have the essential educational and technical qualifications and experience required for the post consistent with the requirement of maintenance of efficiency of administration.
- 5. According to the DoPT OM No. 14014/02/2012-dated 16.01.2013, compassionate appointment can be made upto a maximum of 5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in any Group C post. Presently, there are 04 posts lying vacant to be filled up under compassionate quota i.e. 01 each in the grade of Steno Grade II, LDC, SCD (OG) and MTS. The eligibility criteria of the said posts as prescribed in existing Recruitment Rules is as under:

There are 13 compassionate cases pending in the Directorate for appointment against the 04 posts lying vacant under 5% direct recruitment quota. The Competent Authority for appointing Group B & C candidates in the Directorate is the Director, Directorate of Enforcement. Accordingly, with the approval of the Director, Directorate of Enforcement, this Directorate has devised the point based system for assessing the claims of compassionate cases in compliance of DoPT OM F.No. 43019/9/2019-Estt. (D) dated 23.08.2021. Thus, for assessing the claims of these 13 compassionate cases, the details in prescribed proforma was called from all the concerned Regional SDEs/Zonal Office/Sub Zonal Office along with the devised point based system for processing the case further. The points in r/o each applicant was calculated on the basis of 100 point criterion with 09 variables (viz. Family pension, retirement benefits/lump sum amount received by family on death, monthly income, moveable property/immoveable property, number of dependents, no. of unmarried daughters, no. of minor children, left over service and physically/mentally challenged and chronic disease case) adopted by the Directorate and the same has been forwarded by the concerned Regional/ Zonal/Sub-Zonal Office with the certification of the concerned Regional/Zonal/Sub Zonal Officer. Scrutiny of the 13 applications who possess the educational qualification of matriculation and above, along with the enclosed documents was carried out to select the most eligible candidates by applying the merit points devised by this Directorate. On the basis of the relative point based system devised by this Directorate, the points obtained by the applicants (approved by the concerned Regional/Zonal/Sub-Zonal Officer) is as under:

- * In addition to the above, cases where wife of deceased Official has applied for compassionate appointment for herself, she shall get 15 additional points as grace points. She will be in line with the general principle that the widow needs to be given preference for compassionate appointment.
- 7. As per the DoPT OM F.No. 43019/9/2019-Estt. (D) dated 23.08.2021, prior to the meeting of the Committee, the applicants should be informed through email or other forms of communication about the date of the meeting, no. of vacancies for which they are being considered. Accordingly, all the applicants vide email dated 05.07.2022 were informed about the date of the meeting and the number of vacancies to be filled on compassionate basis in the following grades:

In reference to this Office email dated 05.07.2022, Smt. Sakshi Yadav w/o Late Sh. Manish Yadav, UDC vide letter dated 08.07.2022 informed that she is the sole care taker of her son and family and it will be difficult for her to learn Stenography and shorthand at this age, so she has requested this Directorate not to consider her for the post of Stenographer Grade II and consider her name for the next available option.

- 8. Further, as per DoPT OM F.No. 43019/9/2019-Estt. (D) dated 23.08.2021, every valid application shall be assessed strictly on the basis of the point based merit system formulated by the concerned administrative Ministry/Department. The Committee should make its recommendation for appointment on compassionate grounds as per the total points obtained by each applicant, under the applicable point based merit system.
- 9. Furthermore, with the approval of the Competent Authority, a Trade Test Committee has been constituted for conducting trade test in r/o Staff Car Driver in the Directorate and the composition of the Trade Test Committee is as under:

- 5 (i.e. Sh. Nakul & Sh. Rahul (applicant at S.No. 6) for the post of Stenographer Grade II as the applicants meets the educational qualification criteria required for the said post.

- 14.
