GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Bid Submission:

i. Tenderers are advised to follow the instructions "Special Instructions to Bidders for e-submission of the bids online through eProcurement Portal" available on the <u>https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u> (given at Annexure-VI for ready reference) for online submission of bids. Bid documents may be scanned with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

The technical bid shall accompany Earnest Money (EMD) or bid ii. security Rs. 1,50,000 /-(One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) Account Payee Demand Draft/Banker's cheque .Fixed Deposit Receipts or Bank in favour of the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, Guarantee Enforcement Directorate, Guwahati . Bids without EMD shall be summarily rejected. All bidders shall submit EMD or bid security except Micro and Small Enterprises as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or are registered with the Central Purchase Organisation or the concerned Ministry or Department or start ups as recognized by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP). The bidders shall submit a copy of valid certificates in technical bid cover in support of their claim for exemption from submission of prescribed EMD. The Earnest Money or bid security shall have validity period of 45 days beyond the final bid validity period & must be submitted with technical bid, failing which bid shall be summarily rejected without consideration.

iii. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded within thirty days after the completion of the tender process. No interest will be payable on account of EMD. The EMD will be forfeited in case the bidder asks for modification in his /her bids or do not accept the contract after being awarded the same. The EMD of the successful bidder will be returned only after entering into the contract and submission of a Bank Guarantee of prescribed amount.

iv. The Successful bidder will have to furnish a Performance Security of amount equivalent to 3% of the gross quoted value in the form of either a Bank Guarantee, valid for 60 days beyond the term of the contract, issued by a scheduled bank as per format at Annexure – VI or



a Demand Draft issued by a Scheduled Bank, favouring "DDO, Enforcement Directorate, Guwahati". No claim shall be made against Enforcement Directorate, Guwahati in respect of interest accrued, if any, due on the Performance Security Deposit.

v. The performance of the engaged agency will be assessed as on regular basis and the agency ready to meet terms and conditions as stipulated in NIT should submit their bids. Technical bid shall include documentary proof in respect of each of the aforementioned points of Technical terms and conditions. Financial bids of Agencies, failing to fulfill the above conditions, will not be considered.

vi. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by bidders having business relationship among themselves. Under no circumstances will father and his son(s] or other close relations who have business relationship with one another [i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

2. Process and manner of submission: -

- i. The tenders are to be submitted only ONLINE in two parts viz:
 - (a) "Technical Bid" which should contain technical parameters like as given in the General Terms and Conditions (Annexure-I) and Terms and Conditions for the Tender (Annexure-II) in the format as per Annexure-III.
 - (b) "Financial Bid" which should indicate the item wise rate in the format as per Annexure-IV.
 - ii. All the pages of bid documents must be signed and sequentially numbered by the bidder irrespective of nature of content of the documents before uploading.

3. Other details:

For Financial Bid:

Bidder shall submit the Financial Bid as per format provided in Annexure- IV quoting the prices per items/ installation charges (inclusive of all costs and services including the charges for the delivery and commissioning facilities including taxes) and other vital details thereof, must be uploaded.

4. Important Information

i. The Technical Bids will be opened in the office of the Joint Director, Directorate of Enforcement, Guwahati Zonal Office I & II, 6th Floor, Mainaak Tower, Chirstian Basti, Guwahati -781005 on the scheduled date and time. Separate communication shall be sent regarding date of opening of Financial Bids to technically successful bidders.

ii. All the interested parties / bidders may remain present in the office of the Joint Director, Directorate of Enforcement, GWZO I & II, 6th Floor, Mainaak Tower, Chirstian Basti, Guwahati -781005 as mentioned above at the time of opening of bids on the date and time as mentioned in the critical date sheet.

iii. After evaluation of the technical bids, bidders will get the information regarding their eligibility/pre-qualification on CPP portal / website. Thereafter, an e-mail confirmation will be sent to the successful bidders which can be checked by the bidders on the portal. The financial bids of the successful bidders (found to be qualified in the technical bid) will be decrypted and opened online on the schedule date after the pre-scheduled time by the bid openers. The bidders will get the information regarding the status of their financial bid and ranking of bidders on the website.



iv. The hard copy of the original instrument in respect of the bid security, must be delivered to this office on or before bid opening date/time. After opening of the Technical Bid, the original documents as per the requirement of e-tender document will be verified by the department. The department reserves the right to seek any document in original related to the items offered for installation and commissioning for the purpose of verification at any stage of the tender process.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CCTV SURVEILLANCE AND MONITORING SYSTEM FOR DIRECTORATE OF ENFORCEMENT, GUWAHATI ZONAL OFFICE, ZONE-I & ZONE-II.

- a) Bidder has to comply with latest BIS standards for the supply of CCTV & NVR (with latest features including Access control systems-alarm transmission, Video-loss/Tampering detection Video Content Analytics systems, global standards-ONVIF support)- combined and/or integrated systems even fire detection and fire alarm systems (limited to command, control software and associated systems)- Intruder and hold-up alarm systems (including perimeter intruder detection systems) etc. complying above BIS or identical IES Standards. Other allied equipment for the installation of CCTV Surveillance Systems should adhere to BIS Standards. Bidders should comply with BIS Standard i.e. IS 16910 (Part 2/Sec 32): 2020 or International Standards IEC 62676-2-32: 2019 in respect of video surveillance system for use in security applications, video transmission protocols and recording control and replay based on web services for guidance and use.
- b) Bidders has to comply with BIS standard IS 16910 (part2/sec 32): 2020 or identical to international standard i.e., IEC 62676-2-32:2019 standards defined for video interfaces used in video surveillance systems in security applications that also specifies the web service interface for the configuration of the recording of video, audio and metadata. Additionally, associated events are defined.
- c) OEMs/Product owners to ensure that their product complies with a set of regulations outlined in the **BIS standard IS 16910 (part2/sec 32): 2020** or identical to International standard i.e. 62676-2-32:2019. Further, as the scope defines the standard is for web service interface for configuration of the recording of video, audio and metadata and other equipment must be compatible and comply with BIS standards so that in future no technical glitz would arise in synchronization and smooth functioning of the system due to incompatible equipment/technology. At any stage such incompatibility/synchronization issues arise vendor will be sole responsible and vendor has to replace/remove and install suitable equipment without charging further more.



- d) CCTVs are to be installed at all entry-exit points, main gate and outside the washrooms/toilets, all corridors, lobby, verandas/out houses, reception area, outside the building. Number of Dome Cameras and Bullet Cameras to be installed at Directorate of Enforcement Guwahati Zonal Office is 40 & 10 respectively.
- e) The Cameras range should be **10-30 meters minimum**, should **have night vision** with both **video & audio** enabled.
- f) One 64 Channel Network Video Recorder (NVR) is needed for Guwahati Zonal Office. The NVR should support 16 TB/or more capacity hard disk so that it may support video recording storage upto 18 months.
- g) For display, one monitor is needed.
- h) There should be **minimum power backup of 2 hours**, provided separately with UPS and Battery System for NVR in all premises.
- i) The CCTV footage should be stored for at least 18 months without any replacement of hard disk. Storage System/Backup Media should have forensic attributes as mentioned in BIS standard IS 16910 (part2/sec 32): 2020 or identical to international standard i.e. 62676-2-32:2019 standards defined for video interfaces used in video surveillance systems in security applications that also specifies the web service interface for the configuration of the recording of video, audio and metadata. Additionally, associated events are defined.
- j) The tender is for Supply, Installation and Maintenance of Cameras. The proposal is to be inclusive of AMC for five years (post warranty).
- k) The successful bidder shall attend complaints or requirements any Directorate of Enforcement offices located at Guwahati, in relation with CCTV within 24 Hrs. Rates quoted for Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) shall cover all incidental costs attached except spare parts or equipment while attending the complaints or requirements. Backup of the footage as requested by aforesaid offices shall be provided by the successful bidder within 24 hours.
- 1) Bidders are welcome to visit the premises and assess the technical requirements of installation of surveillance system during the office hours.

- m)On successful completion of the Bid the said contractor shall install the CCTVs on all work locations within **10 days**.
- n) During installation, Bidder shall not change the brand or specification of the product without prior approval of the DD (Infra.) Directorate of Enforcement, Guwahati Zonal office.

Other Terms and Conditions

- 1. Directorate of Enforcement, Guwahati Zonal Office reserves the right to postpone and/or extend the date of receipt/opening of Rates/Quotation or to withdraw the same, without assigning any reason thereof.
- 2. The bidders are required to quote rates only after satisfying each and every condition as laid down.
- 3. The rates quoted must be written both in figures and in words and should indicate leviable taxes, if any. The rates quoted must be mentioned both in figures and in words and should indicate leviable taxes, if any. Corrections, if any, are to be made only be crossing out, initialing, dating and clearly rewriting. In case of discrepancy between the words and figures, the rates indicated in figures shall prevail. All over writing/cutting, insertions shall be authenticated and attested.
- 4. No deviation in the Terms & Conditions and Scope of Work shall be entertained unless specifically mentioned by the bidder in the rates/quotations and accepted by the Directorate of Enforcement. Additional Technical specifications/Standards emerging due to policy matter, may be introduced/relaxed before finalization of Tender process.
- 5. The Directorate of Enforcement shall not entertain any claim arising out of mishap, if any, which may take place. In the event of any liability/claim falling on the Directorate of Enforcement, the same shall be reimbursed/ indemnified by the Bidder.
- 6. Bidder shall in no case lease/transfer/subject/appoint care taker for services agreed to be provided to the Directorate of Enforcement.
- 7. No other person except Bidder's authorized representative shall be allowed to enter the premises of the Directorate of Enforcement.



- 8. Payment will only be made to the contractor through Bank. The successful bidder will have to provide their Bank Account Number, Branch, IFSC Code, PAN Number and a copy their cancelled cheque to the Directorate for the purpose of making payment.
- 9. Bidder should issue Invoices on completion of installation of CCTVs & Monitoring System at Directorate of Enforcement, Guwahati Zonal Office.
- 10. After completion of the work, the successful bidder shall submit successful completion certificate from Deputy Director presenting bill for payment.
- 11. Penal provisions for not attending the complaints/requirements within 24 hours after intimation during AMC/ warranty period is Rs 500 per day which shall be deducted from the bills.
- 12. In case of shifting of the office of Directorate of Enforcement, Guwahati Zonal Office, vendor shall shift the installed integrated/part of the system at new place. Cost levied on it shall be paid as per GFR rules.

 - ii. Bidder should have capability/resources of providing maintenance services within 24 hours and documentary evidence regarding resources such as in the form of branch office or agreement with local service provider shall be submitted by the bidder.
 - iii. Bidder should produce self-attested copy of PAN & GST Registration Certificate.
 - iv. Bidder should produce a current (date should be on or after publishing of Bid) self-declaration certificate regarding never been blacklisted by any State Government / Central Government/PSU in the past for any reason.

Instructions for Online Bid Submission:

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at <u>http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>.

REGISTRATION

1) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrolment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.

2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.

3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.

4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify/ nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.

5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.

6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS
